- 7. Growing up can be hard. Is there an age you didn't enjoy?
- 8. Our tastes in many areas change as we get older. What did you like before that you don't like now? What did you dislike before but now enjoy?
- 9. Do you respect the elderly? How do you show your respect?
- 10. Are young people less polite than they used to be? If so, why is this?



- 11. Do you ever give advice to people who are younger than you? What advice could you give to a teenager?
- 12. Have you met any grumpy old men or women? What makes them seem unhappy?
- 13. When is it okay to ask someone their age? Do you mind telling people your age?
- 14. What is the best age for a person to settle down and get married? Why?
- 15. Would you date someone much older or younger than you? What's the maximum age difference you would accept?
