- 10. Is a good reason to have children to avoid being lonely later in life?
- 11. What makes it so expensive to raise a child these days?
- 12. If raising children were free, how many children would you like to have?
- 13. Some parents want their children to have the best of everything. As a parent, would you try to give your children high quality or expensive things?
- 14. Children usually love sweet foods. How important is the food that children eat? Does it have to be healthy?
- 15. Would you put a lot of pressure on your kids to study hard? Why or why not?
