## **Discussion Questions:**

- 4. Would you let your children go trick or treating without adult supervision? Why or why not?
- 5. What is your favorite kind of candy or treat? What kind of treat would you be disappointed to receive?
- 6. If some kids come to your house on Halloween, and you don't give them any candy, what might they do to you or your house?
- 7. Have you ever been to a Halloween party or some other kind of costume party? What did you dress as? What happened at the party?
- 8. These days, people don't just wear scary costumes. They wear costumes based on many things including popular news stories and politicians. Is this against the original scary spirit of Halloween?
- 9. Many Halloween costumes for adults seem sexy or overly revealing. Why are these kinds of costumes popular?
- 10. What is your all-time favorite scary monster or creature of the night?
- 11. Do you like horror movies? Why or why not? If so, what's your favorite scary movie?
- 12. Have you ever carved a *jack-o-lantern*? How difficult or easy was it to carve?
- 13. Some people decorate their house to celebrate Halloween. Do you decorate your home to celebrate any special days?
- 14. Are you scared of the dark? If not, what advice can you give to people who feel scared when the lights are out?
- 15. Celebrating Halloween has origins in remembering the dead and confronting the concept of death with humor. How do you feel about death?
